

We salute the 228,000 Georgians who served in Southeast Asia, and pay tribute to the 1,584 who were Killed in Action, the 8,534 who were Wounded in Action, the 21 held as Prisoners of War, the 30 still Missing in Action, the 22 whose remains were repatriated, and the 1 who died as a Prisoner of War.
