
Budget:

Grant Program:

- SSG Fox Suicide Prevention Grant Program- (\$747,464)
 - We are in partnership with Kennesaw State University AMES Center to implement the grant.
 The latest data was transmitted to the VA on November 6, 2023.
 - Calandra Ferguson provided the outreach and training data reports, and we transmitted them to the VA on November 6, 2023.
 - Calandra Ferguson or Veda Brooks will report all the outreach and training events regarding Suicide Prevention under the Fox Grant.
 - The SSG Fox Grant Year 2 Kickoff meeting with the AMES Center at Kennesaw State University was conducted on November 8, 2023, to discuss the plan for the coming year.

- o The end of year FER/FFR reports are due January 15, 2023.
- <u>Unite-Us Grant</u>- (American Rescue Plan-Negative Impact Grant)- \$6.1m per year (\$18.3m) over the course of 3 years starting July 1, 2022:
 - Data ingestion and secure data transfer for the platform and social connector is moving forward. As of November 9, 2023, we have <u>265,973</u> veterans in the system. We have submitted <u>956</u> community partners and <u>313</u> healthcare partners for inclusion to the platform since August 2022.
 - Our Warner Robins GDVS office is ranked #6 with 3826 Unite Us referrals received in the entire national network.
 - o Below is an activity snapshot from Unite Us Insights:



- Veterans Mental Health Services Program Grant (HB 414)- Georgia Governor Brian Kemp signed HB 414 on April 25, 2023, with the support of state legislators and the Georgia Department of Veterans Service (GDVS). The bill creates the Veterans Mental Health Services Program, which is a grant program to improve access to mental health services for military service members, veterans, and their families in the state of Georgia. The grant program is funded through state appropriations in Fiscal Year 2023. The total grant funding is \$750,000 for FY2023 (executed by no later than 30 June 2023). The grant was awarded to two vendors:
 - Aspire (Cohen Veterans Network) for \$650,000.

- Emory Healthcare for \$100,000.
- The money was allocated to both awardees, and they have received the funds.
- The first quarterly reports received on October 23, 2023, and both agencies are in compliance with grant guidelines.

Division Updates

1. GDVS Newsletter – PID published a monthly newsletter in October. The e-newsletter features top stories from the month and encourages readers to get the full issue at

- 2. TCSG/Unite Us External Affairs and Communications continued working with TCSG and Unite Us partners on an upcoming narrative and video piece to promote the network of resources in place across the state for veterans and their families. After identifying and connecting a successful veteran, we assisted a VSO with questions, provided information to our partners, and coordinated a film crew visit at GDVS Central Office to highlight the great work GDVS, TCSG, and WorkSource can achieve together using Unite Us.
- 3. Women Veterans Symposium assisted Women, Minority, and Diverse Veterans Coordinator Veda Brooks with an information fair at Saint Philip AME Church in Atlanta. External Affairs helped create new materials for outreach and suicide prevention awareness which were first distributed at the event and helped guide veterans to resources while in attendance. Veterans received help with benefits questions, finding women veteran resources, and were able to get information on suicide prevention.

Commissioner Ross announced that GDVS participated in various Veterans Day Activities.

Commissioner Ross announced a meeting with the newly formed Veteran Action Group that met on November 15 at TCSG. Representatives from the VA, VISN 7, Community Engagement Board, Senator Ossoff's office, the Georgia House and Senate and GDVS were present. They identified the top issues facing veterans in Georgia and worked on narrowing down the issues the group can collaborate on to benefit our veterans.

Ms. Swan visited the Augusta War Home and spent time with some of the veterans there.

The transition at the Milledgeville Home is going well and morale is great among the staff and patients. STGi is very involved in the activities at the Home.

NEW BUSINESS:

We have taken care of our legislative submissions, which include clarifying language on small business tax and the homestead exemption for veterans. We are also trying to get inflationary increases for the homes and raises for our cemetery workers.

We have been given land in Waycross for a Veterans Home. We will have to match 35% of the cost from state funds and fundraising, which is about \$25 million. There are nursing programs in nearby schools that could be used to staff a new home.

Mr. Hanley noted that we need to invite the Veterans Service Foundation members to these monthly meetings.

The December 19 Board meeting was scheduled. It will be a combination virtual and in-person meeting, set up at the GDVS.
